- This is an active, walking tour, spread over several buildings.
- Tours of the collection last approximately 2+ hours.
- All tours are arranged in advance by E-mail correspondence.
- Please advise us as to the ages of the people in your group so we can properly accommodate them.
- A cell phone contact number for each group is needed in case communication is necessary on the day of your tour.
- Donations can be made via cash or check. We are unable to accept credit cards.

For Business and Industry:

- Armed services and defense industry groups access to the collection for training on specific vehicles or systems is available. Please contact the MVTF to inquire about fees and scheduling visits.
