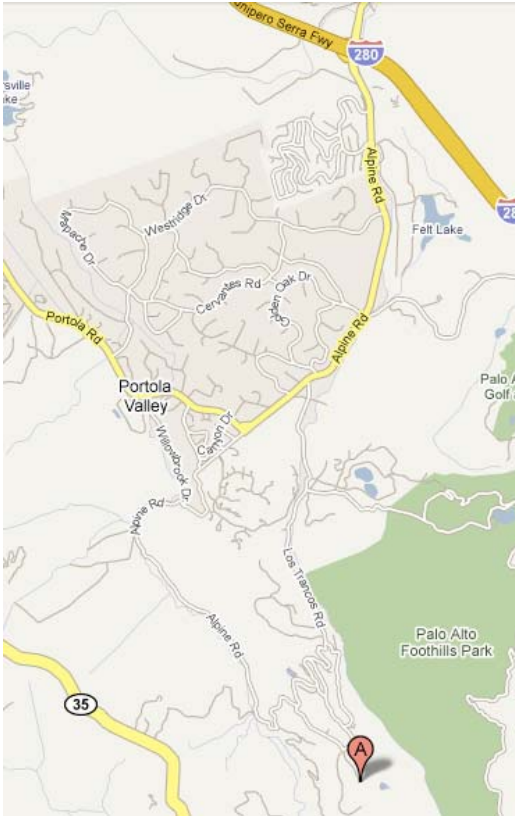

DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO MUSEUM

We recommend that you bring these directions with you for your tour as people are often misdirected by their navigation systems

From Interstate 280 Northbound or Southbound:

Take the **Alpine Road Exit** (Portola Valley) and turn west, towards the hills, onto Alpine Road

Proceed on Alpine Road for approximately 2.4 miles.

Turn **LEFT** at **Los Trancos Road** and proceed for about 1.9 miles.

Turn **LEFT** on **Ramona Road** and proceed for about 0.7 miles.

Turn **LEFT** on **Vista Verde Way** and proceed for about 0.3 miles.

Turn **LEFT** at **Old Spanish Trail** and proceed on Old Spanish Trail for about 0.1 miles

Old Spanish Trail will end at a wrought iron gate, and a sign reading "Pony Tracks Ranch" to your left. Pull close to the gates, as they have been programmed to open automatically for your tour. Proceed on the ranch road and take the first **LEFT**. **Follow the posted signs** down the **gravel road**, past the wooden structure labeled "Office", until you reach a complex of **FOUR LARGE METAL BUILDINGS**. You have arrived at your destination and will meet your tour guide here.

*** As parking is limited for large groups, please try and carpool whenever possible***
